- (b) What is your impression on Shylock's treatment by Shakespeare in the play- The Merchant of Venice?
- $5 \times 2 = 10$ 4. Answer any *two* questions from the following in about 200 words each:
 - (a) Write a short note on the casket scene (Act II, Sc Vii) in the Merchant of Venice.
 - (b) How does Portia's intervention save Antonio's life in the trial scene (Act IV, Sc i)?
 - (c) Write a short note on Bassanio's friendship with Antonio.
